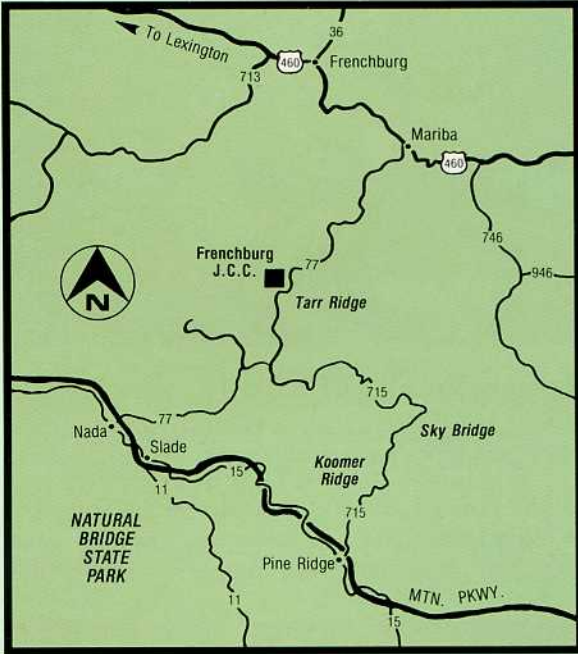

## The Center

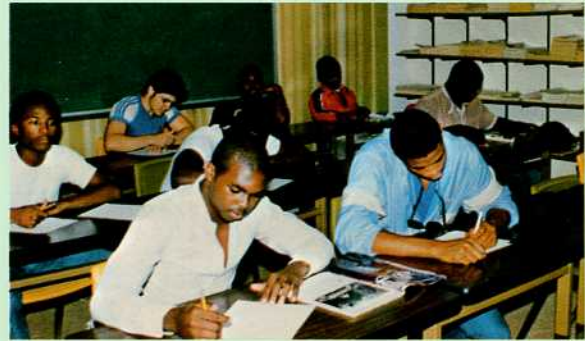
Frenchburg CCC Job Corps is located on Highway 77, approximately ten miles from Frenchburg, Kentucky, in the Daniel Boone National Forest. It is one of the co-educational residential training centers managed by the Forest Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture and the U.S. Department of Labor.

Most of the buildings on this Center have been built by Corpsmembers as part of their learning process. The Center is pleased with the quality of workmanship that has gone into the structures. Our dormitories are modern and pleasant with a capacity to house 56 Corpsmembers in each dorm. The dorm in the photograph below is called the Penthouse.

## Health Care

You receive basic health and medical services, including dental and eye care, as well as an initial examination when you arrive at the Center.

## Meals

You dine cafeteria-style in a bright, comfortable dining room. Meals are served three times a day on weekends with a hearty brunch and dinner on weekends.

## Pay

In Job Corps you earn while you learn, starting at \$40.00 a month with a possibility of earning up to \$100.00 a month. Raises are based on good performance, achievement and length of stay in Job Corps. Payday is twice a month.

Another \$75.00 to \$100.00 a month is set aside for you, and after you complete the program, it's used to help you begin your new job.

## Clothing

An annual clothing allowance of \$317.00 will be given to you the first year of enrollment, with \$103 for the second year.

In addition, all vocational and protective clothing such as rain gear, boots, hard hats, etc., are provided at no cost to you.

## Leisure Time

The Frenchburg Center Recreation Program includes arts and crafts, sports activities, games and movies. Recreational activities will change with the seasons. The Center does provide off-Center trips to various activities and various towns. Special leisure time recreational trips to the Lexington, Kentucky area are scheduled for viewing professional sports events, exhibitions, and musical shows. Admissions to many of these events are at reduced rates. Other activities include swimming, skating, dances and movies. Group recreational outlets in nearby communities are very limited with exceptions of annual community events or festivals, consequently the majority of the Center Recreational programming is provided on-Center on in the City of Lexington.
