



The Center

Pine Knot Job Corps Center is located near the border of Kentucky and Tennessee in the historic Daniel Boone National Forest 110 miles south of Lexington, KY. We are located 5 miles north of the Tennessee border on U.S. 27, 30 miles south of Somerset, KY, 21 miles west of Williamsburg, KY, and 13 miles north of Oneida, TN. The Big Southfork National River and Recreation Area is west and south of the center. The center currently serves 224 male residents with plans to become coeducational in the near future. There are four modern dormitory complexes, each having a lounge area for visiting, reading, watching television and social activities. Laundry facilities are available on center.



Education and Training

Our purpose is to prepare you for the working world. You learn at your own pace while you attend education classes and receive training in a variety of vocational areas.

Health Care

You receive basic health and medical services, including dental and eye care, as well as an initial examination when you arrive at the Center.

Meals

You dine cafeteria-style in a bright, comfortable dining room. Meals are served three times a day on weekends with a hearty brunch and dinner on weekends.

Pay

In Job Corps you earn while you learn, starting at \$40.00 a month with a possibility of earning up to \$100.00 a month. Raises are based on good performance, achievement and length of stay in Job Corps. Payday is twice a month.

Another \$75.00 to \$100.00 a month is set aside for you, and after you complete the program, it's used to help you begin your new job.

Clothing

An annual clothing allowance of \$317.00 will be given to you the first year of enrollment, with \$103 for the second year.

In addition, all vocational and protective clothing such as rain gear, boots, hard hats, etc., are provided at no cost to you.

Leisure Time

Recreation at Pine Knot includes use of a gymnasium, outdoor basketball and tennis courts, a baseball field, universal weight machines, pool and other game tables, and video games. Corpsmembers can participate in intramural sports and swim in the center's pool. Arts and crafts are available in the gym and the canteen is open nightly. Weekend passes are available as are trips to nearby scenic and metropolitan areas.
