



The Center

Schenck is located in the beautiful Pisgah National Forest, approximately 35 miles south of Asheville, North Carolina. The center serves 224 young men who are housed in rustic but comfortable pole-structure dormitories. Each dorm has a lounge area for watching TV, playing small games and for other social activities. Each student is assigned a bed and a locker.



Education and Training

Our purpose is to prepare you for the working world. You learn at your own pace while you attend education classes and receive training in a variety of vocational areas.

Health Care

You receive basic health and medical services, including dental and eye care, as well as an initial examination when you arrive at the Center.

Meals

You dine cafeteria-style in a bright, comfortable dining room. Meals are served three times a day on weekends with a hearty brunch and dinner on weekends.

Pay

In Job Corps you earn while you learn, starting at \$40.00 a month with a possibility of earning up to \$100.00 a month. Raises are based on good performance, achievement and length of stay in Job Corps. Payday is twice a month.

Another \$75.00 to \$100.00 a month is set aside for you, and after you complete the program, it's used to help you begin your new job.

Clothing

An annual clothing allowance of \$317.00 will be given to you the first year of enrollment, with \$103 for the second year.

In addition, all vocational and protective clothing such as rain gear, boots, hard hats, etc., are provided at no cost to you.

Leisure Time

Recreation at Schenck includes a gymnasium, basketball courts, a softball field, universal weight machine, swimming pool, arts and crafts shop and pool tables. Students may also participate in the various organizations, including Corpsmember Government, Big Brothers and the Leadership program. On weekends, students can take passes or stay on center to enjoy the many special activities such as visits by girls from another center, trips to concerts and amusement parks, skating, bowling and fishing.
