MARYLAND CONSERVATI

The Maryland Conservation Corps (MCC) is looking for a few good people to undertake a very important task. MCC participants have the responsibility of helping to restore our state's greatest natural resource – the Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries throughout the State of Maryland.

WORK REQUIREMENTS AND JOB DESCRIPTION

- ★ You must be between 14 and 21 years of age.
- ★ No experience is necessary.
- ★ Hourly wage
- ★ You will receive your pay check every two weeks on Friday.
- ★ Work schedules start in June or July and continue six, seven or eight weeks depending on your area.
- ★ Transportation to and from worksites will be furnished.
- ★ You will work in the county in which you live.
- ★ Learning is a key part of MCC's program. Training is incorporated into your various tasks at the worksite.
- ★ You will be required to wear a MCC t-shirt, hard hat and safety equipment provided by MCC.
Long pants are required.
- ★ You will be paid while attending field trips to learn more about the environment and the Bay.
